YEARLY CLUBS—In the past, we have offered various clubs—Christmas, Sampler and most recently the canvas ornaments. Designers and companies have always been very generous in providing us with free charts and designs and that allowed us to share them with all of you. However, due to the internet and recent issues with piracy and copyright problems, many designers have not only stopped doing these charts but have decided to entirely discontinue designing for the industry. Although we are hopeful that such issues will be resolved, that could take awhile since it has been occurring for some time.

As a result, I am sorry to say that we will not be offering a club at the start of this year. If something presents itself, we may be able to do a club or a series in the later half of the year. We will continue to offer free charts and kits for cross stitch and canvas pieces as the charts become available, so please watch for those in the coming months. We will try to offer one each month, alternating between the two media.

Just a note regarding copyright issues: It is not only WRONG to copy a chart and give it to someone else, it is ILLEGAL. It violates the rights of the owner of that copyright and puts the designers and the shops out of business. **PLEASE** consider what it will do and whom it will affect if you ever make copies of charts and give them to someone or share charts on the internet.


PLUM STREET SAMPLERS—Olga the cat now has a companion Boris, the dog; Dust of Snow is a new sampler; Sea Hag
