framed and get the discount on all of them (excludes frames from Valley House Primitives).



TSP ANNIVERSARY CHALLENGE—By this time in the New Year, many of you have gone through your stash and made decisions on new projects that you want to start or works in progress that you need to finish. Perhaps you have come across pieces that are kitted up and ready to go, everything is there and you just want to get it started, sooner rather than later! Maybe you have something almost finished but need to add some special stitches, beads or embellishments to complete it? Here's how the challenge works:

We will offer a challenge list for you to complete with the projects entered that you



- Your list will have a place for twelve projects that you want to stitch on. Take before pictures of each of those projects. Starting with the month of April, we will select a number from 1-12 at random and that number will correspond with which number project you work on throughout the month.
- Of course, if you complete that piece, you can move on to another on the list or start another new one that didn't make the cut!
- At the end of each month, show us a picture
  of the before <u>and</u> after progress or the
  completion of your piece. Finished entries
  will go in a random drawing for a gift
  certificate each month.
- On the first of the next month we will choose another number and by the time our next anniversary rolls around you will have twelve completed pieces or have made a nice dent in some of your unfinished works!

Keep in mind this is not a competition. It is a personal challenge, designed to provide encouragement and camaraderie among stitchers. We hope this challenge will be an incentive to plan more time for stitching and inspire you to complete and share your stitching challenges!

## **NEW RIGHT NOW**

2019 MONTHLY SERIES—The new year is off to a busy start with several monthly series available. The first of these is a series from Little House Needleworks called Jack Frost's Tree Farm. The series will begin in February and will consist of seven designs. The first one will be the topper, the large design that will go at the top if you are stitching them all together. Six smaller designs will follow and go under that piece in two rows of three each. The design was stitched with Classic Colorworks threads on 30 count Portobello linen.

Erica Michaels has a series that started at the end of 2018 called **Defining the Seasons**. This seasonal series describes, in words and images, various ideas and details that come to mind throughout the year. The primary design is stitched on silk gauze with colorful blocks and words on a tonal background of subtle details and the months from the calendar. An additional piece

using the large letter blocks is finished as a pretty cushion. We have **Defining Winter** stitched in the shop both ways but on fabric so you can see what they look like if you don't want to attempt silk gauze.

Country Cottage Needleworks started their Glitter Village at the end of last year and it will continue for another six months. It consists of nine designs that can be stitched together or as separate pieces on a 32 count that has a little silver thread running thru it. It features houses and trees with a snowy sparkly effect.

**Summer House Stitche Workes** is doing a new **Fragments in Time** series inspired by Quaker illustrations. There will be eight smalls depicting Quaker life and they can be stitched individually or all together on one piece of fabric. There will be a free border pattern if you want to stitch them all together. Stitched with Gentle Art Sampler





Threads and Classic Colorworks, the first two designs are the **Orchard** and the **Workshop**.

**Cottage Garden Samplings** is half way through their wonderful series of **Songbirds**! There are 12 in the series and each one is more elegant than the last with their featured bird and motifs.

As always, you can sign up for any of these automatic series at any time and we will get you caught up on those that have already been released. Stay tuned, there will be lots of new things coming and possibly more series as well once we return from the Nashville show!

MILL HILL—Fun spring bead and button kits feature Flamingos, a Sugar Cookie House and a Hibiscus. The smaller ornament kits have an old fashioned Swim Suit, a Beach Ball with a small crab on it, a Tricolor Pansy and a Hedgehog!

SHEPHERD'S BUSH—Have Ewe Any Wool is a free chart that comes with the fabric and a little wool hat button to keep your sheep warm!

HEART IN HAND—2019 Collector's Heart has the saying "with my whole heart, for my whole life" and would make a sweet little wedding sampler if you add names and a date; Bird in Hand: Valentine's Day

**NEW LINENS**—We have 4 new neutral colors of 37 count linen in stock from Access Commodities. The colors currently available are Aesthetic White, Cloudburst, Russian Tea Cake and Wild Honey.

# **CLASSES**

#### General class conditions:

- Call or come in to reserve your class. Please do not just show up & assume a spot is available!

BEGINNING CROSS STITCH – If you are interested in learning how to cross stitch, anyone in the shop will be glad to offer you guidance. We'll give you a swatch of fabric, show you the basic stitch and how it is done and you can try it out. We have a set of beginning instructions that will help you get started too. Do you have questions after already giving it a try? We'll be happy to answer those and give you some helpful hints or tips. You may want to follow-up by trying the Stitching Over 2 class. Stop by the shop anytime so we can assist you in beginning or continuing on your needlework journey!



STITCHING OVER 2 – This class is a great opportunity to try working on a higher count of

fabric, stitching over two threads. Dianna will share her knowledge about linen and evenweave fabrics, as well as the variety of threads that are available and some helpful tips, as you stitch on a small project.

**BEGINNING NEEDLEPOINT** – During this class, you'll learn two of the basic needlepoint stitches (continental and basketweave) allowing you to work on any canvas.
